I have also enclosed a Tyler Coin Club information sheet. Please fill this out and bring with you to our next meeting. One of my biggest questions is:

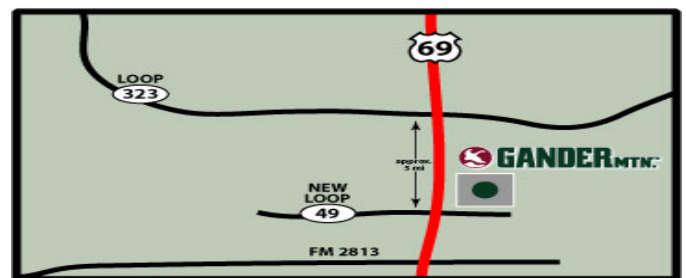
